Loud enough to get audience attention	Loud	
<b>Environmental Ambience</b>	<b>Frequency</b>	
Set up for beginning of show	Sound effect	
<b>Music</b>	<b>Duration</b>	
NA	Bridge in until shower is done up to 30 seconds	
<b>Vocal Alteration</b>	<b>Envelope</b>	
NA	Fade up to over previous music	
<b>Vocal Substitution</b>	<b>Timbre</b>	
NA	Sound effect, higher range, less full	
<b>Extension of Dramatic Space/Time</b>	<b>Directionality</b>	<b>Notes</b>  Shower sound effect

<b>Mood</b>	Upstage behind door to bathroom
