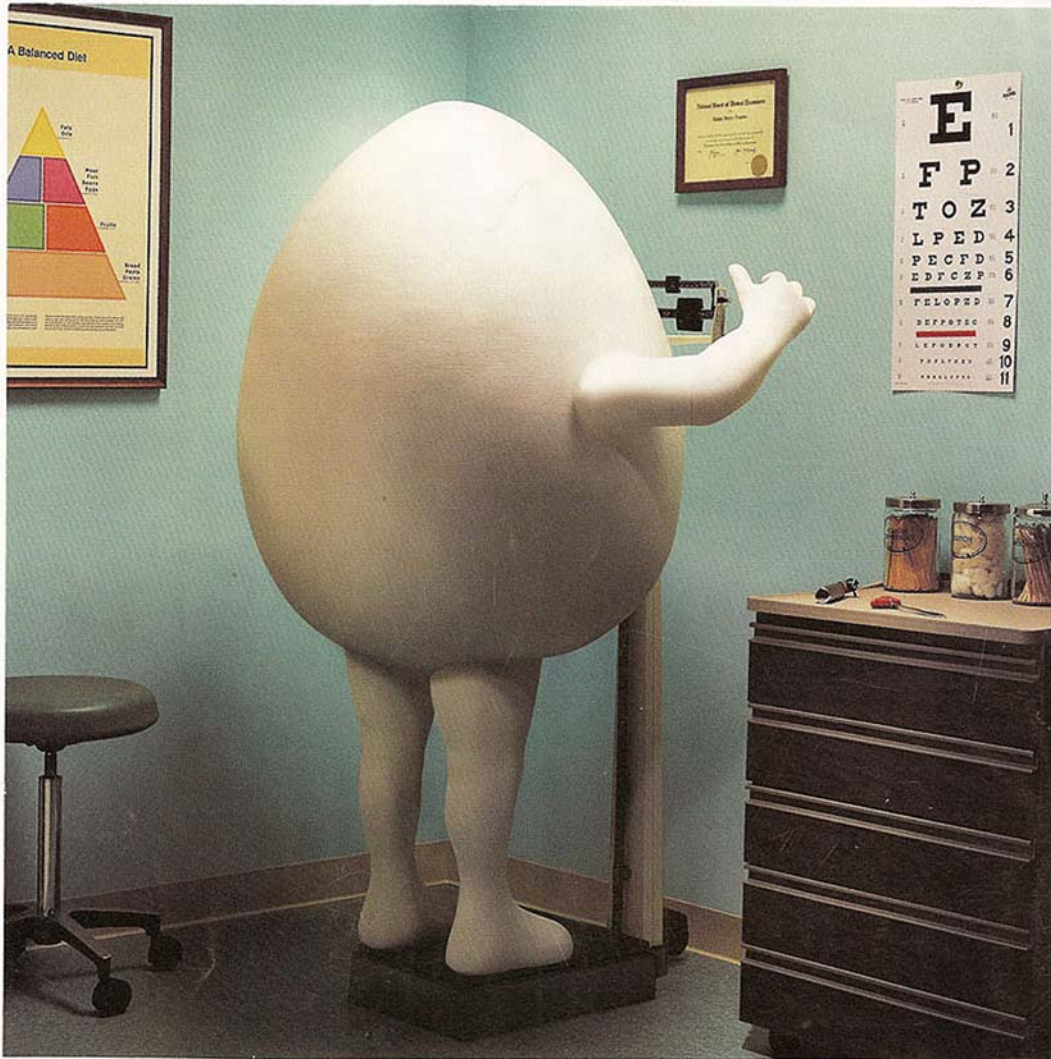


Lighting Morgue

Each week bring to class one photo, magazine advertisement, or color printed web photo (*not from a theatrical production!*) that you will use for your lighting morgues. For each photo you need to provide the following information: a title (be creative!), date, a brief description of what is in the photo, why you chose it in relationship to the lighting topics discussed in class for the week. Compile neatly in a binder or folder. Here are some examples.

TITLE: An egg weight.



DATE: Week 2

BRIEF DESCRIPTION: The harsh reality of cold white light from above is characteristic of the yearly checkup.

WHY CHOSE IT: The enhancing overhead white light seems to expose the naked truth.

TITLE: Tennis or nap?



DATE: Week 7

BRIEF DESCRIPTION: The soft warm summer sun is inviting one to sit in the chair and relax or is it to grab the racket first and play an invigorating game of tennis?

WHY CHOSE IT: The warm welcome invitation to sit in the chair in the sun/partial shade (or play tennis) and the color difference of the chair (much cooler blue) in the shade than in the shade.
